Small Organisations' Development Pathway - use as much, or as little, of this resource as you like - it's free for "Not for Profit", Bexley Groups

What's the offer?

Timeline:

- 1. Month 1: to advertise on our website you must at minimum have appropriate insurance in place, plus safeguarding and confidentiality policies (we can help you to set these up)
- 2. By 4 months on the small hubs pathway, we would work with you to set up the following policies: Equal Opportunities/ Diversity; and Health and Safety
- 3. After 6 months of dedicated support, we would expect a Volunteer Policy and ongoing appropriate supervision to be in place for the volunteers who support your organisation.
- 4. After that, the basics are in place. We will continue to support you at the pace that your organisations needs just ask.....
